At the finals, applicants will have the opportunity to win up to \$15,000 USD in individual funding, up to \$70,000 USD in total prize money, a year membership to AAAS, and every finalist will also receive up to 3 months one-on-one mentorship with top experts in their field or subject of interest.

This is an exceptionally exciting competition and here at AAAS we are extremely excited to ensure that all who are eligible to apply have the opportunity to do so.

Application deadline is March 20, 2015.
